Why it matters

What We Do

- Host virtual collaboration spaces (e.g., Basecamp) to sustain connection and alignment
- Strengthen network leadership and governance to support shared stewardship

What This Looks Like in Action

Through the Strong Families, Thriving Children, Connected Communities (SFTCCC) network, over 200 changemakers across sectors are working together to reduce neglect and improve family well-being in Wisconsin by sharing strategies, removing barriers, and driving collective action.

2. Facilitate learning, dialogue, and collaborative leadership
3. Support networks to sustain themselves and grow their impact over time
