 - CIP Project Enhancements

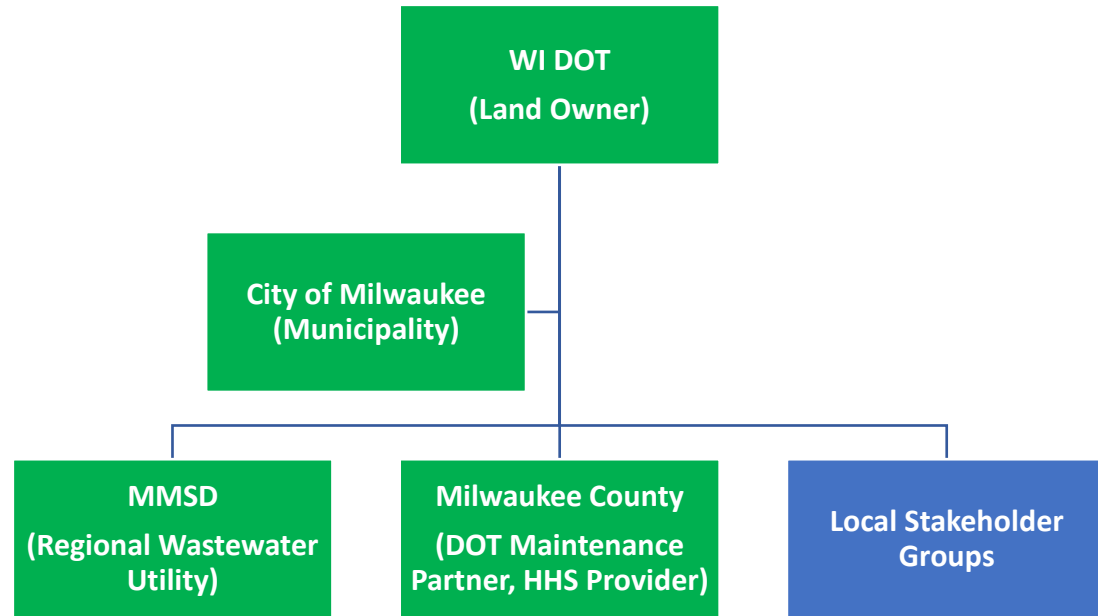


Marquette Overpass Green Infrastructure
