## Course Recommendations for majors leading to a Bachelor of Arts degree from the College of Letters \& Science

## Who can Use this Guide:

- Students who took their first college class in September 2013 or later
- Students who plan to transfer from WCTC to UWM-Milwaukee campus to complete a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree
- Students who do not intend to finish the Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree at WCTC

If you took any college class anywhere before 09/2013 or if you have finished your AA or AS degree through WCTC, consult a UWM admissions counselor at let-sci@uwm.edu. Students who have fully finished the AA or AS degree through WCTC will be deemed to have satisfied some of our requirements regardless of the specific classes that were taken at WCTC.

## Introduction

Many students choose to start at WCTC and continue their education later at UWM. This guide outlines recommended course selections at WCTC for a student who intends to transfer to the Milwaukee campus to complete a Bachelor of Arts degree.

Note: This guide does not replace the advice of an advisor who can provide personalized guidance based on your particular circumstances and background.

## Goal

While at WCTC, students can work towards some of the following degree requirements on a pathway towards a BA from the College of Letters \& Science.
$\checkmark$ Arts Requirement (3 credits required) - nothing offered at WCTC satisfies this requirement
$\checkmark$ Oral and Written Communication/English Requirement (English 102 and an advanced class required) - both Part A and Part B can be completed at WCTC
$\checkmark$ Quantitative Literacy/Math Part A and Part B (College algebra and statistics required) - can be completed at WCTC
$\checkmark$ Natural Science Requirement (12 credits required including at least two labs) -twelve credits can be completed at WCTC
$\checkmark$ Humanities Requirement ( 12 credits required) - all twelve credits can be completed at WCTC
$\checkmark$ Social Science Requirement ( 12 credits required) - twelve credits can be completed at WCTC
$\checkmark$ Cultural Diversity Requirement (3 credits) - one class is available at WCTC to satisfy this requirement
$\checkmark$ International Requirement ( 9 credits) - nothing offered at WCTC satisfies this requirement
$\checkmark$ World Language Requirement - nothing offered at WCTC satisfies this requirement

- 4 years of a single language other than English in high school OR
- 4 semesters of a single language other than English in college OR
- 2 to 3 years of a single language other than English in high school +2 semesters of a different language in college (excluding English and the language that was taken in high school)
