### Nation:

The print inventory is arranged alphabetically by country.

### State, Locale:

Following nation, the inventory is then arranged by state and locale. For all Saville images, both the state and locale is identified.

### Collection and Photo number:

The "Collection" column denotes the photographer's name. Each photo is mounted and matted in the scrapbook, in numerical sequence. A number was assigned by the AGSL for inventorying purposes.

### Description:

For all images in this collection, the scene or description is taken from the photographers annotations in the scrapbook under each photograph. Descriptions within brackets are notes added by the AGSL to clarify or correct spelling mistakes (for example: see line 3 of the sample inventory).

### Date:

For all prints in the Saville collection, the year is known and listed in this column.
