Trauma Informed Care Graduate Certificate/TIC

Four departments are participating in this interdisciplinary certificate program—Social Work, Educational Psychology, Nursing, and Occupational Therapy—and accordingly, the program curriculum will consist of courses offered via multiple campus departments.

- *Students will complete 15 graduate level credits (see below for approved course list) with a grade of B or better to meet the TIC requirements.*
- *Students must maintain a CUM GPA of 3.0 to remain in the certificate program.*
- *Students have three years from initial enrollment in the certificate sequence to complete certificate.*
- *The results of this program is reflected on the student's UWM transcript.*
- *The semester in which a student plans to complete the certificate is the semester to apply via PAWS for graduation.*
