

How to Apply

Trauma Informed Care Graduate Certificate

Application Deadline

January 1, for a Fall Start
September 1 for a Spring start

Eligibility

To be eligible for the "Trauma Informed Care Graduate Certificate through the College of Nursing, applicants need to meet one of the following categories:

- ◆ **Post Baccalaureate Student**-A student who has completed a bachelor's degree in nursing with a grade point average of 2.75 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) and is not currently enrolled in a graduate degree at UWM.
- ◆ **Current UWM Graduate Student**- A current UWM graduate nursing student enrolled in good academic standing
- ◆ **Post Graduate Student**- A student who has completed a nursing graduate degree with a grade point average of 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 scale).

Application Process

To be considered for admission, all applicants must apply through the Graduate School's application system: Panthera. Go to the UWM Graduate School website, and select "Apply", next, select Graduate Certificate Programs, next, scroll down to "Trauma Informed Care" and select.

- Complete online Graduate School Application and include the following materials listed below.
- Pay a nonrefundable application fee
- Upload unofficial transcripts from all and any schools attended (regardless of how long ago it may have been) Applicants will be required to submit official transcripts **after** an admission offer is accepted
