

COMPLIANCE-RELATED REQUIREMENTS AT TRANSACTION POINTS FOR SPONSORED PROJECT PERSONNEL

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OVERVIEW

There are a number of federal, state, University of Wisconsin System, and University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee regulations and policies that govern extramurallyfunded projects and programs on campus. These regulations and policies include:

- Wisconsin State Statute 35.93, UW System Chapter 8: Unclassified Code of Ethics
- Wisconsin State Statute 946.13, Private Interest in Public Contracts
- University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Policy on Effort, Commitments, and Effort Certification
- National Science Foundation Award & Administration Guide, Chapter IV—Grantee Standards: Conflict of Interest (COI) Policies
- Public Health Service (PHS)¹ Financial Conflict of Interest (FCOI) Policy

To help the research community comply with these regulations and policies, the chart below identifies the various compliance-related tasks required by project personnel for proposal submissions, award set-up, non-competing continuations, and no-cost extensions.
