Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement**

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**Purpose:** To facilitate articulation between the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) Early Childhood Education AAS programs and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UWM) Community Education.

WTCS students who successfully complete an A.A.S. degree in Early Childhood Education (WTCS statewide core curriculum) wishing to transfer to UWM will be awarded the following credits toward a BS degree in Community Education. These credits are awarded for courses on WTCS campuses that have different names and course numbers that will appear on the student's transcript in order for them to receive UWM credit.

Additional Conditions:

1. Acceptance into the UWM program is based upon academic and non-academic criteria determined by the Department of Educational Policy and Community Studies.
2. The UWM baccalaureate candidate must also meet UWM's General Education and Cultural Diversity Requirements.
3. Program-to-Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the degree specified in this agreement. A change of major invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement for a different major at UWM.
4. Course equivalencies used in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the course curriculum of the WTCS Early Childhood Program undergoes revision.
5. WTCS degree must be posted on official transcript to receive credits from the agreement.
6. The maximum number of credits that can be transferred from WTCS to UWM is 72.
7. Credits will be granted under this agreement only for WTCS courses in which a student has earned a grade of C or better.
8. WTCS students must have an Associate Degree in Early Childhood Education earned after December 31, 1989. Course work must have been taken since January 1, 1987.
9. Community Education majors must meet regular University requirements for admission. Admission to UWM does NOT guarantee admission to the program in the UWM School of Education. To be eligible to apply for admission to the School of Education program, students must meet the following condition: a 2.0 cumulative grade point average on transferable credits (it must be emphasized that a 2.0 GPA is the minimum and does not guarantee acceptance into the professional program).
