Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the College of Health Sciences as an "intended" Communication Sciences & Disorders major after two semesters at a UW-College campus, students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

Recommended Course Plan

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Communication Sciences & Disorders from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your UW-Colleges course work. To make sufficient progress towards your degree and to potentially graduate in four years, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 2 semesters at a UWC campus and begin your coursework at UWM during the fall semester.

It's possible to be concurrently enrolled at a UW-College and UWM. Concurrent enrollment would allow you to take the required courses for your major at UWM while finishing up other course work at a UW-College. Consult a UW-Colleges advisor to explore your options, and to plan curriculum that fully transfers to UWM and fills prerequisites, General Education Requirement credit, and other program requirements.

Communication Sciences & Disorders Major Application Requirements

Generally, students apply to the Communication Sciences & Disorders Major at the end of their sophomore year. It is important to plan ahead so that you will meet the following requirements on time:

- Completion of 58 credits with a minimum 2.500 undergraduate cumulative GPA on all courses attempted at UWM
- Completion of General Education Requirements
- A minimum 2.750 grade point average in Communication Sciences & Disorders courses 220, 230 & 240 on first attempt (non-repeatable)
