Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the College of Health Sciences as an “intended” Occupational Studies major after two semesters at a UW-College campus, students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

Recommended Course Plan

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Occupational Studies from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your UW-Colleges course work. To make sufficient progress towards your degree and to potentially graduate in four years, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 2 semesters at a UW-College campus.

Concurrent enrollment at both a UW-College and UWM would allow you to take the required courses for your major at UWM while finishing up other course work at a UW-College. Consult a UW-Colleges advisor to explore your options, and to plan curriculum that fully transfers to UWM and fills prerequisites, General Education Requirement credit, and other program requirements.
