 - Priority Application Deadline for Spring: **November 1st**
- Submit all appropriate transcripts to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, P.O. Box 749, Milwaukee, WI 53201
 - Include Official High School transcripts and/or GED/HSED score report
 - Include all post-secondary transcripts

- Please note that there are 13 UW-Colleges. Not all UW-Colleges offer every course listed. Work with your UW-Colleges Academic Advisor or Transfer Specialist to plan your schedule based on what is offered.
- You can be guaranteed admission to UW-Milwaukee by participating in the UW-Colleges [Guaranteed Transfer Program](#). After fulfilling certain credit and grade point average requirements, you will transfer with the same rights and privileges as those who begin their education at UWM. Your admission is guaranteed into UWM, not into your program. Ask your Academic Advisor or UW-Colleges Transfer Specialist for more information.

Admission Requirements

Level 1: Pre-Architecture

- To be admitted to the Pre-Architecture program, all students must pass ENG 102 and MAT 124 with a grade "C" or better
- Freshman must earn at least a 2.5 undergraduate GPA on 24 attempted credits
- Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors must earn at least a 2.75 GPA on their overall college record and required courses

Level 2: Architectural Studies

- UW-Colleges transfer students may not be admitted directly into Level 2: Architectural Studies, as Level 2 admission requires Architecture courses that are not available through any UW-Colleges (see Recommended Course Plan for more information)

NOTE: Achieving Level 1 admission allows students to take Pre-Architecture courses at UWM (ARCH 100, ARCH 101 and ARCH 280). Admission to Level 1 is not guaranteed and is highly competitive; however, priority of admission is given to students with a strong academic record and GPA.

Recommended Course Plan

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Architecture from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your UW-Colleges course work. It's in your best interest to consult a UW-Colleges advisor for assistance planning your schedule

For this program, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 24 credits at a UWC campus, depending on course offerings. It's possible to be concurrently enrolled at a UW-College and UWM. If you have been admitted into the Level 1: Pre-Architecture program, you may enroll concurrently in Level 2: Architectural Studies at UWM while finishing up other course work at a UW-College. ARCH 100 (fall only) and ARCH 101 (spring only) are offered through UWM on campus and online. Please contact an advisor from your UW-College Student Services Office to discuss your options.
