 - Include Official High School transcripts and/or GED/HSED score report
 - Include all post-secondary transcripts

UW-Colleges to UWM: Information Studies Course Equivalencies

Information Studies courses are not offered at any of the UW-Colleges, however a transfer student can complete their General Education Requirements and Cross-Functional Electives during their first two years. Cross-functional electives can be satisfied with an approved 3-credit course in each of five categories: Technical Arts, Communication, Philosophy/Psychology, Business and Library/Information Science (recommended at UWM). Additionally, students could begin their General Electives, which are meant to build a minor of study.
