- Submit all appropriate transcripts to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, P.O. Box 749, Milwaukee, WI 53201
 - Include Official High School transcripts and/or GED/HSED score report
 - Include all post-secondary transcripts

Articulation Agreement: Program to Program Transfer Conditions from Mechanical Engineering Technology at WCTC to Mechanical Engineering at UWM

Students who have or will receive an Associate Degree in Mechanical Engineering Technology from WCTC fall 2008 or later are eligible to transfer as a junior into the UWM Mechanical Engineering Program. Review the following with a WCTC Transfer Specialist:

- The student has earned the Associate Degree with a minimum GPA of 2.75 in all math, science and engineering courses
- The student has met the General Education Requirements in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences and Natural Sciences and must complete a 3-credit Cultural Diversity course and meet the UWM GER English and foreign language competency requirements
- Transfer equivalencies below are only accepted for transfer students in the Mechanical Engineering program
- Transfer equivalencies below are subject to change in the event that the curricula of WCTC or UWM undergoes revision
- The agreement may not apply to students who have completed college work prior to enrolling at WCTC
