UW-Milwaukee is pleased to announce the following scholarship in support of African American/Black undergraduates during the final year of their degree program. This scholarship is intended to positively impact a student's path toward graduation by helping to ease the financial burden of college expenses. This is a non-renewable scholarship made possible through the generosity of the African American Faculty Staff Council (AAFSC) at UWM, and is to be used during the 2018-2019 academic year.

**Amount of Award:** \$3,000 total available (\$500 for December graduates and \$1,000 for May graduates)

**Eligibility Requirements**

1. Must be an undergraduate African American/Black student who plans to graduate in December 2018 *or* May 2019.
2. Must have attained senior standing prior to the start of the 2018 fall semester.
3. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.80 or higher.
4. Must be currently enrolled at UWM either full- or part-time in the 2018 spring semester.
5. Must have declared a major in any degree program (not open to undecided majors).
6. Demonstrated financial need. Completion of the 2017-2018 or 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the application due date below is strongly recommended. FAFSA results will be reviewed as a standard measure of financial need.
