Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must be an undergraduate African American/Black student who plans to graduate in December 2018 *or* May 2019.
- 2. Must have attained senior standing prior to the start of the 2018 fall semester.
- 3. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.80 or higher.
- 4. Must be currently enrolled at UWM either full- or part-time in the 2018 spring semester.
- 5. Must have declared a major in any degree program (not open to undecided majors).
- 6. Demonstrated financial need. Completion of the 2017-2018 or 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the application due date below is strongly recommended. FAFSA results will be reviewed as a standard measure of financial need.
