**Description of Award:**

Through the generosity of the Shorewood Woman's Club, UW-Milwaukee is pleased to announce a scholarship opportunity for undergraduate women planning to continue their studies during the 2018-2019 academic year. The primary purpose of this scholarship is to assist new and returning non-traditional students with completing their UWM degree. This is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship. Prior recipients of this scholarship are not eligible.

**Amount of Award:** \$1,000 minimum; One or two scholarships will be available

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Resident of Wisconsin
- Returning adult student (*must be age 25 or older*), with preference to female applicants
- Undergraduate student who has completed at least one semester at UWM (including spring 2018) with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Minimum half-time enrollment (6 credits)
- Financial Need as determined by filing the 2018-2019 FAFSA
