Admission Guidelines

If you have completed 12 credits of transferable course work you will be considered for admission based on a review of your college records. If you have fewer than 12 transferable credits you may be considered for admission based on a review of both your high school and collegiate records.

Most admitted transfer students have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater on all transferable coursework. Competency in English and mathematics is an important factor in the admission decision.

Please note that some selective programs (Peck School of the Arts, School of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Engineering, College of Nursing) may have additional requirements for direct admission into their majors.

We encourage students to utilize this guide to plan their coursework for their first and second semesters at [other institution]. We highly recommend that students who are interested in transferring contact a UWM Transfer Advisor for more information about additional requirements of specific academic programs.

Admission to Biomedical Sciences – Radiologic Technology

Clinical application is due December 1 of the fall semester: Minimum UWM cumulative GPA of 2.500 or higher and minimum grade required in specified courses. Clinical Placement begins with a competitive application process, and placement is NOT guaranteed. Admitted students will complete a two-year professional clinical training at UWM or an affiliate site. Full-time course enrollment is required during clinical years.

Completion of at least four supervised shadowing hours and a C.N.A. certification are highly recommended.

At the latest, students are advised to transfer to UWM for the fall semester they plan on applying for advancement in the major. Only active, UWM students can apply for advancement. ***Students applying for advancement may repeat four prerequisite courses one time.***

Transfer courses are subject to change at discretion of program director.
