### **Milwaukee Area Technical College to B.S. – Elementary Education in the School of Education**

#### **Admission Guidelines**

If you have completed 12 credits of transferable course work you will be considered for admission based on a review of your college records. If you have fewer than 12 transferable credits you may be considered for admission based on a review of both your high school and collegiate records.

Most admitted transfer students have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater on all transferable coursework. Competency in English and mathematics is an important factor in the admission decision.

Please note that some selective programs (Peck School of the Arts, School of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Engineering, College of Nursing) may have additional requirements for direct admission into their majors.

We encourage students to utilize this guide to plan their coursework for their first and second semesters at [other institution]. We highly recommend that students who are interested in transferring contact a UWM Transfer Advisor for more information about additional requirements of specific academic programs.

#### **Admission to Elementary Education Major Requirements**

- Mandatory meeting with academic advisor in the semester following 40 credit semester.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- Earn a C or better in all courses.
- Successful completion of dispositions and field evaluation from CURRINS 333.
- Successful completion of MATH 175 and ENGLISH 102 (or placement of 4 or higher on English placement test).
