### Milwaukee Area Technical College to B.S. – Exceptional Education in the School of Education Early Childhood Special Education

#### Admission Guidelines

If you have completed 12 credits of transferable course work you will be considered for admission based on a review of your college records. If you have fewer than 12 transferable credits you may be considered for admission based on a review of both your high school and collegiate records.

Most admitted transfer students have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater on all transferable coursework. Competency in English and mathematics is an important factor in the admission decision.

Please note that some selective programs (Peck School of the Arts, School of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Engineering, College of Nursing) may have additional requirements for direct admission into their majors.

We encourage students to utilize this guide to plan their coursework for their first and second semesters at [other institution]. We highly recommend that students who are interested in transferring contact a UWM Transfer Advisor for more information about additional requirements of specific academic programs.

#### Admission to Early Childhood Special Education Major Requirements

- Completion of Thirty Credit Benchmark
  - Mandatory meeting with your advisor
  - Completion of ENGLISH 102 with a C or better or a score of 4 on the English Placement Test and MATH 175 with a C or better
  - Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.25 on all UWM and transfer courses
- Mandatory meeting with your advisor
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on all UWM and transfer courses
- Submit Admission Application – this must be submitted by April 1 in the semester in which you are taking CURRINS 340, 302, and 502
- Content Knowledge Requirement Check
