Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC) to B.F.A. – Film, Video, Animation & New Genres – Peck School of the Arts

Admission Guidelines

Transfer admission is a holistic and selective process, and no single criterion guarantees admission. The following factors are taken into consideration when reviewing applications:

Demonstrated satisfactory academic progress

Successful completion of college-level math and English courses

Total credit hours completed

Academic standing at your previous institution

If you have fewer than 12 transferable credits, we will also review your high school academic records.

Please keep in mind that some academic programs within the Peck School of the Arts, School of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Engineering & Applied Science, and College of Nursing may have additional requirements for direct admission into their majors.

We encourage students to utilize this guide to plan their coursework for their first and second semesters. We highly recommend that students who are interested in transferring contact a UWM Transfer Advisor for more information about additional requirements of specific academic programs.

Admission to Animation BFA Requirements

Students must meet the following criteria for entry into the BFA Film, Video, Animation & New Genres Program:

- Complete 18 credits of Department Foundation introductory film courses and 6 credits of Foundation Studios film courses
- Submit portfolio of work for Foundation Review after completing Department Foundation and Foundation Studios; portfolio reviews occur at the end of both the Fall and Spring semesters
- Satisfy Math and English Part A competencies by either testing out or passing ENGLISH 101 and 102 & MATH 105 or 103 with a grade C or better
- Earn a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA on all coursework

The BA requires 57 credits in the Film curriculum, 18 credits of electives and 45 credits of core (UWM) curriculum, 120 credits total. Students pursing their Bachelor of Arts degree would major in Animation.

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Film from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your MATC coursework. Because required Film coursework is only offered at UWM, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 1 semester at MATC.

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Film from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your MATC course work. To make sufficient progress towards your degree and to graduate in a timely manner, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 1-semester at MATC.

Due to the specificity of courses, students interested in Film should only attend a MATC for a maximum of one semester. Early interaction with UWM's course of study is the most effective way of completing degree requirements in a timely manner. It is strongly recommended that you contact an advisor at UWM in the PSOA as soon as possible to discuss transfer options.
