Waukesha County Technical College (WCTC) to B.F.A. – Theatre – Peck School of the Arts

Admission Guidelines

Transfer admission is a holistic and selective process, and no single criterion guarantees admission. The following factors are taken into consideration when reviewing applications:

Demonstrated satisfactory academic progress

Successful completion of college-level math and English courses

Total credit hours completed

Academic standing at your previous institution

If you have fewer than 12 transferable credits, we will also review your high school academic records.

Please keep in mind that some academic programs within the Peck School of the Arts, School of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Engineering & Applied Science, and College of Nursing may have additional requirements for direct admission into their majors.

We encourage students to utilize this guide to plan their coursework for their first and second semesters. We highly recommend that students who are interested in transferring contact a UWM Transfer Advisor for more information about additional requirements of specific academic programs.

Admission to Theatre Requirements

Students must meet the following criteria for entry into the BFA Theatre Program:

- Earn a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA on all coursework
- Acting and Musical Theatre majors must pass the Theatre Entrance Audition, which is typically scheduled multiple times per
 year on Fridays; dates are posted at www.edu/arts/apply/ (application must be complete 2 weeks prior to audition date)
- · Production majors must complete the application to schedule a required interview for program entry

The BFA in Acting requires 32 credits in core Theatre curriculum, 47 credits of required Theatre curriculum, 6 credits of electives, and 45 credits of core (UWM) curriculum, 130 credits total. Students pursuing their Bachelor of Fine Arts degree would major in Theatre studying Acting.

The BFA in Musical Theatre requires 19 credits in core Theatre curriculum, 59 credits of required Musical Theatre curriculum covering coursework in the Dance, Music, and Theatre departments, 7 credits of related PSOA electives, and 45 credits of core (UWM) curriculum, 130 credits total. Students pursuing their Bachelor of Fine Arts degree would major in Theatre studying Musical Theatre.

The BFA in Production requires 32 credits in core Theatre curriculum, 14 credits of required Theatre curriculum, 29 credits of electives, and 45 credits of core (UWM) curriculum, 120 credits total.

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Theatre from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your MATC coursework. Because most required Theatre coursework is only offered at UWM, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 1 semester at MATC. Students planning to pursue Musical Theatre should plan to begin studies at the main UWM-Milwaukee campus.

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Theatre from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your MATC course work. To make sufficient progress towards your degree and to graduate in a timely manner, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 1-semester at WCTC.

Due to the specificity of courses, students interested in Theatre should only attend a WCTC for a maximum of one semester. Early interaction with UWM's course of study is the most effective way of completing degree requirements in a timely manner. It is strongly recommended that you contact an advisor at UWM in the PSOA as soon as possible to discuss transfer options.
