Waukesha County Technical College (WCTC) to B.F.A. – Music Education – Peck School of the Arts

Admission Guidelines

Transfer admission is a holistic and selective process, and no single criterion guarantees admission. The following factors are taken into consideration when reviewing applications:

- Demonstrated satisfactory academic progress
- Successful completion of college-level math and English courses
- Total credit hours completed
- Academic standing at your previous institution

If you have fewer than 12 transferable credits, we will also review your high school academic records.

Please keep in mind that some academic programs within the Peck School of the Arts, School of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Engineering & Applied Science, and College of Nursing may have additional requirements for direct admission into their majors.

We encourage students to utilize this guide to plan their coursework for their first and second semesters. We highly recommend that students who are interested in transferring contact a UWM Transfer Advisor for more information about additional requirements of specific academic programs.

Admission to Music Requirements

Students must meet the following criteria for entry into the BFA in Music Education Programs:

- Earn a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA on all coursework
- Pass the Music Entrance Audition, which is typically scheduled multiple times per year on Fridays; dates are posted at uwm.edu/arts/apply/ (application must be complete 2 weeks prior to audition date)
- Music Education majors must first pass the music entrance audition and then later apply for acceptance into the major based on specific criteria including programmatic courses/ requirements and Department of Instruction (DPI) requirements. Must also earn a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA.

The BFA in Music Education requires 80-85 credits in Music curriculum, up to 5 credits of electives, and 45 credits of core (UWM) curriculum, 130 credits total. Students pursuing their Bachelor of Fine Arts in Music Education degree would major in Music studying one of the following Tracks:

- General
- Choral & General
- Instrumentation & General

Music Education majors must apply for acceptance in the major based on specific criteria including programmatic courses/requirements and Department of Instruction (DPI) requirements. Must also earn a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA on all coursework.

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Music from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your MATC coursework. Because most required Music coursework is only offered at UWM, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 1 semester.

Recommended Course Plan

If you are interested in obtaining a degree in Music from UW-Milwaukee, the following recommendations have been established to help you plan your MATC course work. To make sufficient progress towards your degree and to graduate in a timely manner, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after 1-semester at WCTC.

Due to the specificity of courses, students interested in Music should only attend a WCTC for a maximum of one semester. Early interaction with UWM's course of study is the most effective way of completing degree requirements in a timely manner. It is strongly recommended that you contact an advisor at UWM in the PSOA as soon as possible to discuss transfer options.
