Ten Questions to Ask About Advising Majors

- 1. What Gen Ed or intro courses do you offer that will help me explore this major?
- 2. If I chose this major, what topics would I study? What's your favorite class in the major?
- 3. What minors or certificates complement this major?
- 4. What careers have alumni pursued with this major? Any unexpected careers?
- 5. What is expected of students entering this major (skills, time commitment, attitude)?
 - Does the major have required GPA or class repeat rules?
 - How long might it take me to finish this major? Would summer classes help?
- 6. Would you consider this a professional major (a major that prepares students for a specific job field) or a liberal arts major (a major that provides students skills and knowledge for many job fields)?
- 7. What classes do students find challenging? What resources and advice help them to succeed?
- 8. What opportunities does the department offer (scholarships, student organizations, etc.)
- 9. Does the program require/encourage an internship, fieldwork, clinical, etc? What level of assistance will I have in finding one?
- 10. If students don't do well in this major, what are related majors they might succeed in?
