- Student's cumulative GPA is in the upper one-third of the student's junior or senior class

QUALIFICATIONS (GRADUATE STUDENTS):

- Completion of a minimum of nine credits in political science graduate coursework (A or B grades in all courses)
- Student is enrolled in a political science graduate program
