

# SUMMER EXPLORATION CAMP



The Mini-Courses Summer Exploration Camp is a two-week academic enrichment program exposing middle school students to hands-on math, science, reading, and writing experiences. Summer Exploration Camp includes activities and/or educational field trips where students explore majors and careers, postsecondary options, study skills and work habits. The camp includes a math and science component week one and a reading and writing component week two. The program will also include various college readiness activities that include, but are not limited to, college panels, career guidance, and an overnight stay in UWM's Residence Halls.

**Week 1: Math & Science**  
*Exploring Sports & Entertainment*

Students will be introduced to math and science concepts and careers relating to sports and entertainment in this exploratory camp. Students will be participating in hands-on workshops and educational field trips.

Students will be staying overnight in the UWM Residence Halls on Thursday, July 24th!  
Camp will conclude on Friday, July 25th at 10:00am.

**Week 2: Reading & Writing**  
*Exploring Animals in Danger*

Students will challenge their skills in reading and writing by working in groups to research, design and present final projects highlighting animals in danger. Students' work will be showcased on Thursday, July 24th.

**Camp will take place in person, on the UWM campus**

- **Class Size:** 50 Students.
- **Eligibility:** Students entering 6th, 7th or 8th grade for the upcoming academic year (Fall 2025). Must have a core GPA of 2.0 or above.
- **Program Fee:** \$325.00 class fee or DPI Pre-College Scholarship\*

\* Students must be eligible for free or reduced lunch to apply for the DPI Pre-College Scholarship
