- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete at least 18 credits in Psychology, including 9 credits of 300-level or higher courses taken at UWM.
- \_\_\_\_\_ You must have an average GPA of at least 2.0 in all courses in the minor, including Psychology courses at UWM and, if a transfer student, courses taken at UWM plus transfer psychology courses.
- \_\_\_\_\_ L&S STUDENTS: Meet with an L&S Advisor (<http://uwm.edu/letters-science/advising/student-advising>) to be sure that you are meeting the L&S and university-wide requirements for graduation.
