
GUIDE TO THE MS KINESIOLOGY APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for admission and funding, the UWM Graduate School and the Kinesiology Program must receive all materials by the following deadlines:

Fall application materials deadline: Jan. 2
Spring application materials deadline: Nov. 1

Items to be submitted to the Graduate School via the Panthera Application System:

- Application Complete the UWM Graduate School application form on-line at: graduateschool-apply.uwm.edu
- Transcripts Transcripts for all colleges, universities, technical schools, and diploma programs you have attended must be uploaded to the Panthera application system. A bachelor's degree from an accredited program, with a minimum undergraduate grade point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale is required for admission to the Graduate School.
- Narrative Statement The Narrative Statement must include:
 - A rationale for graduate study and pursuit of an MS Kinesiology degree
 - Initial selection of primary focus area (Exercise Physiology & Performance, Psychosocial Aspects of Physical Activity/Exercise or Neuromechanics) and whether you have interest in pursuing degree Option A, B or C
 - Long-range career goals
 - Professional, academic, and/or research activities performed during your undergraduate career and/or since receiving your bachelor's degree
 - Strengths you bring to graduate study in Kinesiology at UWM
 - If you are interested in applying for funding (teaching, research, program assistantships, or a Chancellor's Graduate Student Award) please note this in your narrative statement.
- Application Fee Information on the current graduate application fee is available on the Graduate School application form.
- Two Letters of Recommendation Letters of recommendation from two persons familiar with the applicant's academic and professional strengths, and knowledgeable about the applicant's potential for successful graduate study, should be requested from within the application system. A minimum of one individual should be an academic reference.
- International Students only There are additional requirements for international applicants. Please see the current Center for International Education (<http://www4.uwm.edu/cie/futurestudents/69/>) for detailed information on application procedures and requirements
- Personal Interview (Optional) A faculty member may request a personal interview for consideration of admission and/or funding.
