ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

- 1 The UW-Milwaukee baccalaureate candidate must also meet UWM's General Education Requirements and any additional Level 1 requirements of the School of Architecture and Urban Planning (SARUP).
- 2 Completion of SARUP Level 1 requirements does not guarantee admission to the Level 2 program of study. Admission to Level 2 also requires a minimum grade point average of 2.75 in both the overall college record and required Level 1 architecture courses. Students must also pass a portfolio review.

- 3 Program-to-Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the degree specified in this agreement. A change of major invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved with some other Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement for a different major at UW-Milwaukee.
- 4 Course equivalencies specified in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the course curricula of either institution undergo revision.
- 5 The maximum number of credits that can be transferred from MATC to UWM is 72.
- 6 This agreement may not apply to students who completed coursework at the School of Architecture and Urban Planning prior to enrolling at MATC.
- 7 A minimum grade point average of 2.50 on at least 24 credits of transferable MATC coursework is required to transfer to the School of Architecture and Urban Planning.
