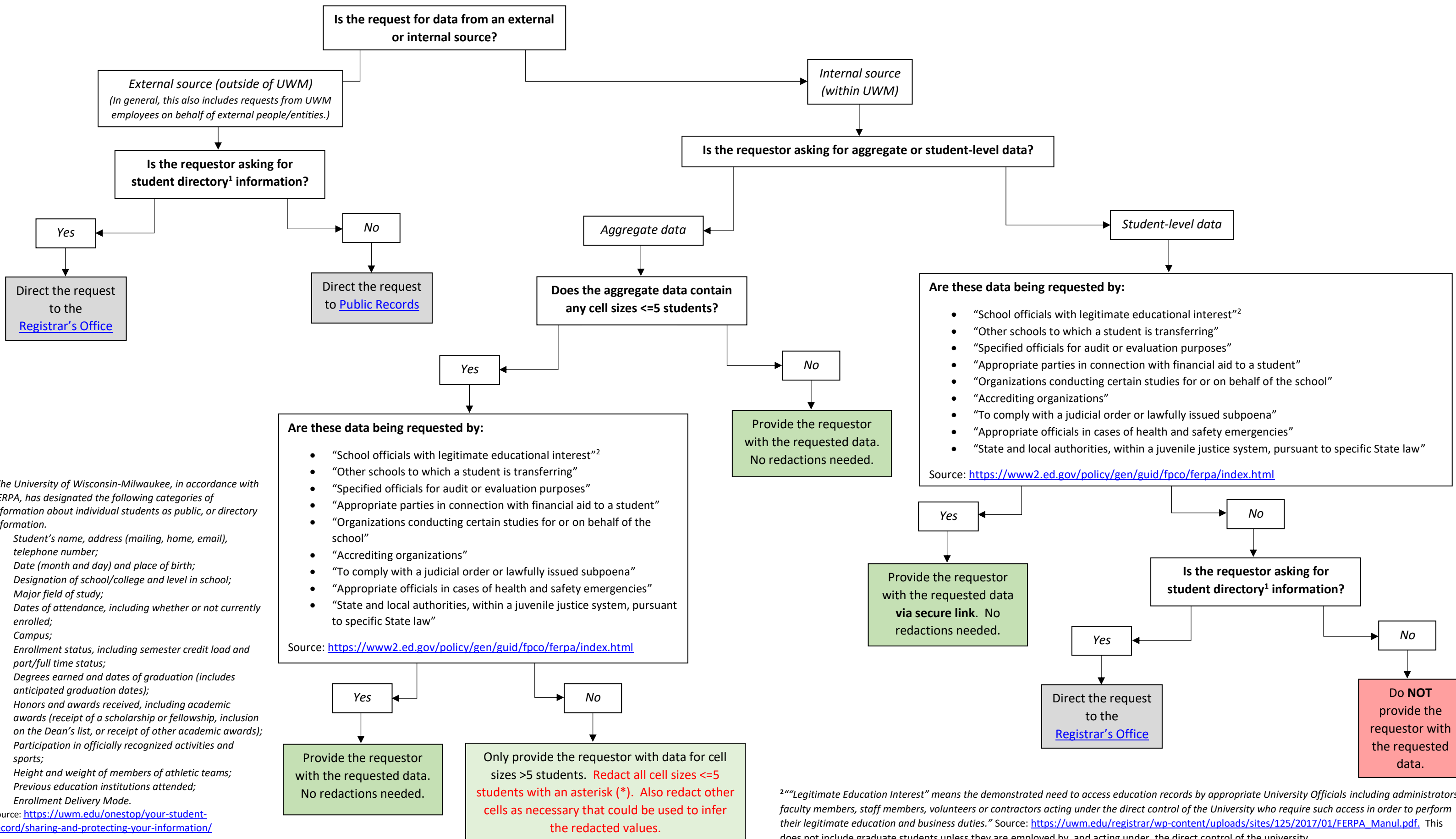


# DGCC Student Data Provision Guidelines



<sup>1</sup>The University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, in accordance with FERPA, has designated the following categories of information about individual students as public, or directory information.

- Student's name, address (mailing, home, email), telephone number;
- Date (month and day) and place of birth;
- Designation of school/college and level in school;
- Major field of study;
- Dates of attendance, including whether or not currently enrolled;
- Campus;
- Enrollment status, including semester credit load and part/full time status;
- Degrees earned and dates of graduation (includes anticipated graduation dates);
- Honors and awards received, including academic awards (receipt of a scholarship or fellowship, inclusion on the Dean's list, or receipt of other academic awards);
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports;
- Height and weight of members of athletic teams;
- Previous education institutions attended;
- Enrollment Delivery Mode.

<sup>2</sup>"Legitimate Education Interest" means the demonstrated need to access education records by appropriate University Officials including administrators, faculty members, staff members, volunteers or contractors acting under the direct control of the University who require such access in order to perform their legitimate education and business duties."
