SAFETY RULES for **DELTA**

BAND SAW

- 1. READ AND UNDERSTAND INSTRUCTION MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING SAW.**
- 2. IF YOU ARE NOT** thoroughly familiar with the operation of Band Saws obtain advice from your supervisor, instructor or other qualified person.
- 3. MAKE SURE** wiring codes and recommended electrical connections are followed and that machine is properly grounded.
- 4. DO NOT** operate while under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication
- 5. ALWAYS** wear eye protection (safety glasses or a face shield).
- 6. REMOVE** tie, rings, watch or other jewelry and roll up sleeves.
- 7. GUARDS** should be in place and used at all times.
- 8. MAKE SURE** that saw blade teeth point downward toward the table.
- 9. ADJUST** the upper blade guide about 1/8" above the material being cut.
- 10. MAKE SURE** that blade tension and blade tracking are properly adjusted.
- 11. STOP** the machine before removing scrap pieces from the table.
- 12. ALWAYS** keep hands and fingers away from the blade.
- 14. HOLD** work piece firmly against the table. **DO NOT** attempt to saw stock that does not have a flat surface, unless a suitable support is used.
- 15. HOLD** material firmly and feed into blade at a moderate speed.
- 16. TURN OFF** the machine if the material is to be backed out of an uncompleted or jammed cut.
- 17. MAKE "release"** cuts before cutting long curves.
- 18. SHUT OFF** power and clean the Band Saw and work area before leaving the machine.
