SAFETY RULES for *POWERMATIC*®

JOINTER

1. READ AND UNDERSTAND THE INSTRUCTION MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING THIS JOINTER.
2. IF YOU ARE NOT thoroughly familiar with the operation of jointers, obtain advice from your supervisor, instructor or other qualified person.
3. MAKE SURE that the machine frame is electrically grounded and that a ground lead is included in the incoming electrical service.
4. ALWAYS wear approved safety goggles, glasses, or a face shield.
5. Do not operate tool while under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or any medication.
6. REMOVE tie, rings, watch and other jewelry and roll up sleeves above the elbows.
7. USE hearing protective devices. DO NOT WEAR GLOVES.
8. MAKE sure machine guards are in place and in good working order. Use them at all times
9. BEFORE turning on machine, remove all extra equipment such as keys, wrenches, scrap, stock, and cleaning rags away from the machine.
10. HOLD the stock firmly AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT use this jointer for other than its intended use.

11. When working a piece of wood on the jointer, follow the 3 inch radius rule (SEE FIG. 1). The hands must never be closer than 3 inches to the cutterhead.

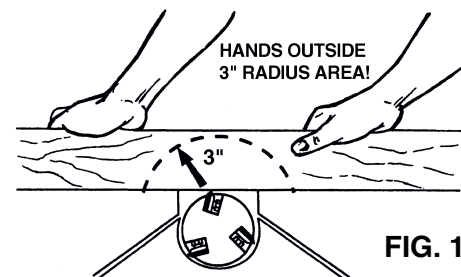

12. NEVER apply pressure to stock directly over the cutterhead. This may result in the stock tipping into the cutterhead along with the operator's fingers. Follow the 3 inch rule. Position hands away from extreme ends of stock, and push through with a smooth, even motion.
13. SOME DUST created by power sanding, sawing, grinding, drilling and other construction activities contains chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
14. SHUT OFF the power and do not leave until the wheel has come to a complete stop and the work area is clean when finished using machine.
