PANEL SAWS AND PANEL ROUTERS

PANEL SAW

- 1. READ AND UNDERSTAND INSTRUCTION MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING SAW.**
- 2. IF YOU ARE NOT thoroughly familiar with the operation of Circular Saws, obtain advice from your supervisor, instructor or other qualified person.**
- 3. MAKE SURE wiring codes and recommended electrical connections are followed and that machine is properly grounded.**
- 4. DO NOT operate while under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication.**
- 5. ALWAYS wear eye protection (safety glasses or a face shield).**
- 6. REMOVE tie, rings, watch and other jewelry, and roll up sleeves.**
- 7. BLADE GUARDS should be kept in place and used whenever the cutting operation permits.**
- 8. ALWAYS use saw blade guard, splitter and anti-kickback fingers for "through sawing."**
- 9. KEEP hands out of the path of saw blade.**
- 10. STAND to one side, NOT in line with the saw cut when ripping.**
- 11. ALWAYS USE a "push stick" when ripping narrow work.**
- 12. KNOW how to avoid "kickbacks."**
- 13. MAKE all adjustments with the power off.**
- 14. DO NOT perform any operation "freehand." ALWAYS slide the work firmly against the fence.**
- 15. WHEN machine is not in use keep the saw carriage rip lock securely tightened.**
- 16. NEVER reach around the saw blade.**
- 17. KEEP saw blade sharp and free of all rust and pitch.**
- 18. FEEDING material through the machine horizontally or moving the saw carriage the the material vertically MUST BE DONE SLOWLY, SMOOTHLY AND WHENEVER POSSIBLE WITHOUT STOPPING. OVER FEEDING will cause poor quality cuts and over load the saw motor.**
- 19. USE CAUTION when setting material onto the carriage. HEAVY MATERIAL MUST NOT BE DROPPED ONTO THE ROLLER CARRIAGE**
- 20. PANELS being cut horizontally must ALWAYS be fed AGAINST the rotation of the saw blade.**
- 21. SHUT OFF power and clean the saw before you leave it.**
