ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 Structure

The Committee consists of seven members: ~~five~~~~four~~ Instructional and Research academic staff members with indefinite appointment elected by Instructional and Research academic staff members holding probationary or indefinite appointments and ~~two~~~~three~~ tenured faculty members elected by the faculty. No more than two academic staff members may be from any one school/college/division, and no more than ~~one~~~~two~~ faculty members may be from any one school/college/division at the time of their election to the committee.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 Structure

The Committee consists of seven members: five Instructional and Research academic staff members with indefinite appointment elected by Instructional and Research academic staff members holding probationary or indefinite appointments and two tenured faculty members elected by the faculty. No more than two academic staff members may be from any one school/college/division, and no more than one faculty member may be from any one school/college/division at the time of their election to the committee.
