- **E.** Recommendation to Registrar's Office regarding U/G courses:

APCC recommends that the registrar implement separate sections for all U/G courses starting in a phased approach in fall 2019. Separate sections will better distinguish for instructors those students required to do graduate level work from those required to do undergraduate level work; they will create a permanent record of what level of work the student has completed; and they will facilitate a more efficient and reliable system of double counted credit in accelerated master's degrees.
