DEI Leadership Council

• Comprehensive team consisting of reps from campus areas (e.g., Dean's reps, DC reps, Governance, S/C reps, students, DPs)

• Direct and receive info from work teams and forward that to Steering committee



Action Teams

- Faculty, staff and student teams
- Staff will be divided into two work groups (academic and university staff)
- Faculty work group will be formed first and work will begin this semester. (Provost-led)



SEDI Officer

- Senior Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Officer
- Search is launched with two faculty chairs (Dr. William Keith and Dr. Anika Wilson)
- Search committee includes several faculty members

Multi-cultural Centers

- Our four multi-cultural centers will be under the leadership of Dr. Vang, effective 7/1/19
- Spent several weeks working with the Centers to produce job description to reflect role as student success coordinators and to unify offerings and services
- Currently in the process of hiring for vacant positions



Faculty Mentoring Initiative

- Faculty Council will be established for each multi-cultural center.
- Council members will work with students as academic and research mentors, and serve as UWM navigators.
- This is being done in pockets —need to institutionalize the process
