Rationale: the employment categories of tenured assistant professor and tenured instructor no longer exist at UWM.

### 4.04 Departmental Executive Committee: Membership

(1) Each department has a Departmental Executive Committee, consisting of all fulltime members of the department who are tenured professors or tenured associate professors, and as determined by the Departmental Executive Committee at the time of appointment with tenure, any person holding a part-time appointment as a tenured professor or tenured associate professor, provided that this rule shall not be construed to withdraw any membership understandings or arrangements in effect at the time this rule was adopted, and provided further that all persons holding multiple or part-time appointment as a tenured professor or tenured associate professor shall be entitled to membership in at least one (1) Departmental Executive Committee.

### 4.04 Departmental Executive Committee: Membership

(1) Each department has a Departmental Executive Committee, consisting of all fulltime members of the department who are tenured professors or tenured associate professors, and as determined by the Departmental Executive Committee at the time of appointment with tenure, any person holding a part-time appointment as a tenured professor or tenured associate professor, provided that this rule shall not be construed to withdraw any membership understandings or arrangements in effect at the time this rule was adopted, and provided further that all persons holding multiple or part-time appointment as a tenured professor or tenured associate professor shall be entitled to membership in at least one (1) Departmental Executive Committee. The executive committee of a department or non-departmentalized school or college may by a two thirds vote grant membership on the executive committee to a tenured assistant professor or instructor.
