- Human Resources, IT, Finance & Procurement
- June 2018: CTS and SSC1 Launch

- Summer 2019: CTS will serve all of campus
- Fall 2019: SSC2 Launch
 - Covered Units: GEA, SARUP, LSB, CEAS, PSOA, SFS, SOIS, SCE, CGS, Grad School, Office of Research, Libraries

Budget & Finance

- Work to "Balance" Budget
 - Strategic Position Control in place through FY 2019; then convert to New Budget Model
 - Overall Operating Results
 - FY 2018: Unrestricted balances grew by \$8M (result of timing issues)
 - FY 2019: Forecasting \$0-2M in 2019
 - Continuing Decline in Tuition Revenue
 - \$7M in FY 2018
 - \$8M in FY 2019

Budget & Finance

- New Budget Model Implementation FY 2020
 - Completed campus process in January (Unit budget-building work now underway)
 - NBM support team (including APBC reps) will review process for continued improvements
 - Goal better alignment of unit budgets to UWM's strategic goals
 - S/C formula based on SCH, degrees, and research
 - Annual review of central infrastructure budgets

Capital Planning

- 19-21 Capital Budget supported by UW System, Regents, and Governor:
 - New Chemistry Building (\$129M GFSB)
 - Union Renovation/Repairs (\$40M PRSB)
 - Klotsche Annex (\$7M PR Cash)
 - Planning for Additional Engineering Bldg (\$1M)

(If approved by legislature, this will be largest biennial capital budget in history for UWM!)

Capital Planning

- Lubar Entrepreneurship Center & Welcome Center
 - Substantial completion anticipated late March 2019



LECWC Construction Cam March 14, 2019

NWQ Infrastructure –

- Intensive Planning Underway
- Significant budgetary shortfall between \$69M original project cost and \$52M granted

Sustainability

- Climate Action Plan planning
 - CAP planning is ready to launch
 - Preparation underway by graduate course
- Bike Hub Study
 - Endorsed by PEC in December
 - Reviewed campus connectivity and bike parking needs
- UWM has first Waste & Recycling Specialist
 - Created through cost savings generated by the position





Safety & Assurances

- Programs Updated/Overhauled
 - Biosafety Program Refreshed Improved Forms, Processes
 - Human Subjects Research Regulations Revised
 - Occupational Health and Industrial Hygiene Program Manager Hired, Program Overhaul
- Laboratory Safety Guidance 2018
 - 244 faculty, staff, and students attended training
 - 228 labs, shops, studios inspected
- Animal Care Re-Accreditation Visit Summer 2019

Human Resources

- Launch of Chancellor's Employee Learning & Development Advisory Committee
 - Purpose is to develop and maintain vision and strategy for employee learning and development
 - Membership includes faculty and other governance representatives
 - Already completed:
 - Leadership and supervisor training modules mandatory for all new supervisors

UITS

- Information Security Policy Implementation
 - 17 individual projects implementing 7 Regent and UWS policies and procedures
 - 21,000+ implementation hours (dozens of staff)
 - Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) for employees in pilot phase now with anticipated Fall 2019 roll-out
 - MFA for students now on the horizon as well

Unified Communications

 In testing phase now; incremental deployment anticipated to begin this summer

Police/Safety

- Active Shooter Preparedness Plan
 - Update completed with PEC in Fall
- Faculty/Instructor Classroom Safety Training
 - 15 additional sessions this academic year in collaboration with Dean of Students Office

- Coffee with a Cop events
 - Promoting PD vision: Building Relationships –
 Protecting Community
 - 3 events this year, with campus partners
