- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 9:02 am.

Guests: <u>UC Chair Kris O'Connor</u>, Associate VC Dev Venugopalan, CGS Interim Dean Stephen <u>Schmid</u> Roosevelt reported on concerns raised regarding UWM's 4-4 workload policy vs. CGS's 5-5 workload. Schmid reviewed CGS's 5-5 model, noting full-time for IAS is 80% as they teach 4 courses per semester and do not have the research and service requirement of faculty. There would be significant budget impacts if CGS used UWM's workload.
