- I. Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m.
- II. Welcome and Introductions-Chair Yasaitis welcomed everyone to the inaugural meeting of the University Staff Senate. Senators introduced themselves.
- III. Chancellor's Report-The Chancellor congratulated the committee on such an important step moving forward in governance. The move to a University Staff Senate gives parity with Faculty and Academic Staff in a greater voice on our campus and with UW System. The Chancellor just returned from a Board of Regents meeting with a budget update that was more favorable for UWM. Better budgets help us to make necessary repairs and fund new buildings to grow our programs and keep UWM and its students at the forefront of education in Wisconsin.
- IV. Chair's Report-Chair Yasaitis echoed the Chancellor's words discussing the role of senators on campus. It is a great responsibility for members to become leaders on campus to share information and help all University Staff in their role on the Senate.
