

The provision of single-stall, gender inclusive bathrooms is intended to provide safe alternatives to multi-stall, gender-specific bathrooms, which can be problematic and unsafe for students, faculty, staff, and visitors who may be harassed or discriminated against based on their perceived or actual gender identity, gender expression, sex, sexual orientation, ability status or other of actual genuer menuty, genuer expression, sex, sexual orientation, aounty status of other identity as well as other factors that make the use of a private, gender inclusive facility preferable




