 - a. Round Robin introductions of attending members.
- 4. Multi-factor authentication (MFA) at UWM John Goodman and Amanda Brickner
 - a. Project status: currently in open enrollment for MFA, employees can elect to open enroll. An individual elects to enroll and they have 14 days to enroll an electronic device and/or fob. One login offers 12 hours and Office 365 login provides a longer time period (14 days online). All employees must be enrolled by October 31, 2019.
 - b. Communication: this has been a three-stage process: general awareness, targeted communication, and in-person communications.

- 5. LinkedIn Learning Therese Bohn
 - a. Lynda migrated to LinkedIn Learning as of 8/26/19. All Lynda.com users data was migrated over to LinkedIn.  - a. Information Security policy background: UW System is charted through Wisconsin state law and governed by Regents. Policies come from state law, the regents, UW System, and

- UWM (the last of which falls under UWM governance). UWM provides feedback to policies, some of which are adopted. New policies will be brought to ITPC for feedback.
