- I. *Call to Order.* The meeting was called to order by Chair S. Boyd at 3:00 p.m.
- II. *Approval of Agenda and Minutes.* The agenda was approved as amended with adding Announcements item to all agendas. The minutes of the August 28, 2019 meeting were approved as presented.
- III. *Announcements.* The 2021-22 AYC was approved at the September Faculty Senate meeting. S. Boyd gave the annual report at the Senate meeting. Carrie Driscoll, Secretary of the University's Office, located a 2004 report on UWinterim by the APC which evaluated five years of UWinterim and addressed issues raised by Lex Renda, including the 13 days. S. Boyd discussed the findings with Lex Renda and he agreed issue was resolved.
- IV. *New Business.*
 - A. UWM's Academic Misconduct Procedures (UWS Chapter 14 and Fac Doc 1686)- S. Boyd presented the requested revisions to Fac. Doc. 1686. N. Salowitz moved and S. Emmons seconded to update Fac. Doc. 1686 to match UWS 14, Section 14.07 by inserting, "by electronic means" and Section 14.08 by inserting, "electronic means." Motion passed unanimously. The document with tracked changes will be submitted to Codification for review.
 - B. Transfer Completion of Associate Degrees- Kristin Hildebrandt presented the issue to the APC as information and requested feedback. She explained that pre-merger with Waukesha and Washington County, students short a course or two from earning associate degree who then took elsewhere could do a reverse transfer of that coursework to officially complete the AAS degree at UW Colleges. Questions surrounding the issue include: What is the responsibility of the receiving institutions? Should UWM be posting the degree for the prior term (when were technically not yet accredited to offer the AAS)? Should UWM post degrees for a term when were accredited even though that would not be an accurate depiction of when it was actually earned? UW Colleges has indicated that once the UWC records move over to UW Extended Campus as historical records, as a general rule, they will no longer be posting degrees for students in PRISM. K. Hildebrandt will update the APC on what is decided.
