Research Planning

- Update to Campus Plan
 - Working group currently revisiting
 - Dean/associate deans/chairs input
 - Collaborative Research
 - Undergraduate Research
 - Workforce Development for Research
- School and College plans
 - Development started in Spring 2018 at the request of the Provost
 - First draft in January 2019
 - Most been through two versions and reviews
 - Draft #3 was due end January 2020 half submitted




School & College Research Plans

- Challenges
 - Financial constraints
 - Balance teaching, research and service
- Forward-looking Elements
 - Research Objectives
 - Research Development
 - Need to focus research programs ("themes")
 - Collaborations and Partnerships
 - Research Centers and Institutes as collaborative foci
 - Unit-level incentives for research (including "workload")
 - Doctoral program development
 - Linkages to undergraduate education
 - Additional opportunities to enhance revenues
- Main Shortcomings
 - Lack of tangible action plans linked to objectives
 - Need more work with planning committees, faculty, staff

Office of Sponsored Programs

- Staffing
 - New Interim Director: Kate Mollen
 - New Contract Specialist: Anne Kissack
- Roles & Responsibilities
 - Basis for working with units and faculty
 - Service expectations
- Relationships with shared service hubs
 - Less diffuse points-of-service for researchers
 - Improve consistency of post-award functions



Internal Programs

- Internal Program Revisions
 - Discovery and Innovation Grants (DIG)
 - Advancing Research and Creativity (ARC) Grants
 - Team Initiation Program (TIP) Awards
 - Research Travel Awards
 - Support for Undergraduate Research Fellows (SURF)
- Incorporated the former UW-College campuses



Emphasis on Collaborative Research

- Workshops: 25-30% of faculty
- Grant Program for Team Development
 - 13 awards to date
- Research Centers
 - Reviews under 2016 policy
 - Beginning of restructuring toward team research
 - Cross-disciplinary focus of CTSI, CUPH
- School and College Level
 - Strategies that reflect the needs of disciplines
 - Topic-driven research groups
 - Increase in groups approaching OoR for support



Research Compliance

- Roles and Responsibilities
- OAR, FCOI and COC
 - Significant push from Regents
- Research Data Security and Intellectual Property Protection
 - National, System and Institutional concerns
- Export Controls
 - Very low level at present
 - Expect to grow

 - School/College Research Plans
 - Working Group revisiting campus Research Excellence Plan
- Office of Sponsored Programs
 - Restoring staff levels
 - Roles & Responsibilities and associated service expectations
- Internal Research Support Programs
 - Continue to develop collaborative research
 - Assess internal funding program
- Compliance
 - Working Group on improving Research Data Security and Protection of Intellectual Property
 - Possible OAR and COI changes
