 - a. SAAP 10-12 COVID-Related Health & Safety Rules

J. Urdan presented the policy. The revisions were made to incorporate the new UW System testing requirements which include mandatory weekly testing for residential students and biweekly testing for students and employees who visit campus at least once per week.
