

Lead development of UWM strategy to create a sustainable future through implementation of infrastructure and operations, and maximizing resources

Budget & Finance

- Operating Budget Results FY 2020
 - \$1M Net Operating Loss (near Break-even)
 - Biggest Drivers:
 - Continuing Decline in Tuition Revenue (\$7M↓)
 - COVID losses in auxiliaries (\$15M↓)
 - COVID expense reductions (+\$15M)
 - State budget lapse (\$7M↓)
 - Federal CARES funding (+\$7M)

Budget & Finance

- Operating Budget Projections FY 2021
 - \$20-25M Net Operating Loss (w/o fed funds)
 - Biggest Drivers:
 - Continuing Decline in Tuition Revenue (\$12M↓)
 - COVID losses in auxiliaries (\$45M↓)
 - COVID expense reductions (+\$27M)
 - State budget lapse (\$6.5M↓)
 - Federal funding (+\$)

Budget & Finance

- Operating Budget *Planning* FY 2022
 - Assuming a \$11M loss in tuition and state funding
 - Schools/Colleges Declines in Funding
 - Range: 2.8% 5.5% ↓
 - Average: 4.6% **↓**
 - Central Infrastructure Units Declines in Funding
 - All administrative divisions other than Enrollment Management: 6.1%↓
 - Average: 5.5% **↓**
 - Auxiliaries planning underway

Capital Planning

- 19-21 Capital Budget largest in UWM History
 - December 2020 Final Approvals to Construct:
 - Student Union Renovation (\$40.7M)
 - New Chemistry Building & Central Utility Line (\$129.5M)
 - EMS 9th/10th Floor Laboratory Renovation (\$6.6M)
 - February 2021 Final Approval to Construct:
 - Klotsche Annex (\$8.1M)

Capital Planning

- 21-23 Capital Projects Recommended by BOR
 - Old Chemistry Demolition (\$7.1M BTF)
 - Sandburg West Infrastructure Project (\$11.4M PRSB)
 - NWQ Renovation Health Sciences (\$74.8M GFSB)
 - Planning funding for Engineering Building (\$8.2M GFSB)
 - SFS Dock Wall (\$7.1M GFSB)





SFS Dock Wall

- Unified Communications (Microsoft Teams)
 - Deployed in March 2020
 - Replaced landlines and connected communication tools
 - 22,476 meetings via Teams in 2020!
- Information Security Policy Implementation
 - MFA for students in Office 365 completed in Fall 2020
 - MFA for PAWS planned for March 2021
 - Many other major InfoSec tools implemented

- Integrated Shared Services Project
 - Campus Technology Support now services entire UWM
 - Now provides remote desktop support
 - Numerous service improvements underway
 - Hub 2 implemented and final Hub 3 underway
- Space Optimization Project
 - Formal UWM Kickoff for study and planning
 - Sale of Alumni House
 - Funding for NWQA Demolition
 - Funding for Old Chemistry demolition

- UWS Procure to Payment Automation
 - Best-in-class procurement technology platform
 - Planning nearly complete; rollout in April 2021
- UWS Administrative Transformation Project
 - Selected cloud-based Workday to replace existing Peoplesoft HR/Finance Enterprise System
 - System Design begins in 2021
- Enhance Data Management Solutions
 - Established Data Governance Custodial Committee
 - Launched Microsoft Power Bl as new reporting tool

- UWM Climate Action Plan
 - Assessment of Infrastructure, Environment and Community Completed
 - Plan to be Completed in 2021
- Recycling Brought In-House
 - UWM faced dramatic price increases in recycling due to changes in market
 - Internalized contracted work for annual savings
- Police Community Advisory Committee
 - Council charter and membership launched in December
