Program prioritization is happening on some campuses. There was also a presentation on the Title and Total Compensation reform. Availability of vaccines was also discussed.
- B. The Expanded Cabinet met. It was announced that Regent Delgado had just passed away. Other items discussed were the restoration of DACA protections, diversity training, and LGBTQ protections. There was also an enrollment report. University campuses may become sites for vaccination distribution.
