 - b. Campus plans a return to face-to-face teaching in Fall 2021 to as close to prepandemic levels as possible. Campus will continue to monitor things in case any changes need to be adjusted.

 - V) Discussion of policy on low enrolled programs-The chairs distributed the low enrollment documents/report to the committee. The committee was concerned that many of the programs with low enrollment would be difficult to evaluate given the small scope of the document. Budgets often hinder marketing smaller programs. Looking at programs should be evaluated in an even broader scope for the greater good of a program or major. The chairs will send the committee's feedback to Campus Administration.
