 - b. The campus COVID pivot led to changes in normal practices including relief of some parking costs for those required to be on campus at a time public transportation services had been cut or reduced and instances of delayed maintenance of UWM parking facilities to reduce current expenses.
 - c. The final 2020-21 Parking Departments budget illustrated the many challenges the parking department faced in the fiscal year that ended July 1, 2021. It was noted:
 - i. Budgeted Revenues: 5,232,400
 - ii. Actual Revenues: 1,489,562
 - iii. Budgeted Salaries & Fringes: 895,100
 - iv. Actual Salaries & Fringes: 604,072
 - v. Sales Credit (including Covid Relief funds): 1,970,754
 - vi. Operating Income (Loss): (163,932)
 - d. We reviewed upcoming maintenance projects.
- 6. Old Business: No old business was identified.
- 7. New Business:
 - a. Sustainability issues and campus improvements aimed at safety and comfort for bicyclists & pedestrians
 - i. Lower speeds around campus
 - ii. More pedestrian friendly crossings
 - iii. Additional stop signs strategically placed around/near campus
 - iv. Better Integration of NW quadrant into campus
