 - i. Revision to remove the strikethrough text from the GFC Charter regarding exofficio membership: "1) (e) Ex-officio members shall include the chair of the Research Policy Advisory Committee (RPAC) or delegate; a member of the University Committee; the dean, one associate dean, and a staff person from the Graduate School."
 - 1. The Research Policy and Advisory Committee voted unanimously in their Oct. 29, 2021 meeting to remove the RPAC ex-officio requirement from the GFC charter.
 - 2. The University Committee also came to the agreement in their Aug. 31, 2021 meeting that there is little need for an ex-officio member from UC on GFC.

She started in the Journalism, Advertising, and Media Studies undergraduate program at UWM in fall 2015 as a transfer student from UW-Whitewater. She was a McNair Scholar who earned her BA in JAMS and minor in Communication, graduating cum laude in May 2019. Naomi was then awarded an Advance Opportunity Program Fellowship in fall 2019 and entered the Media Studies MA program. In spring 2021, she completed the coursework for her degree. Naomi was finishing her thesis this semester.
