A. Data Analytics, BS - Request for Authorization to Implement (ATI)

There is an increased need among employers for employees with data analytics skills. This program, created by a task force of 10 faculty from across campus, is inter-disciplinary and meets industry needs. A faculty oversight committee will manage this program.

Jay Kapellusch moved to approve the BS in Data Analytics. Shevaun Watson seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
B. Information Security, Graduate Certificate

SOIS offers an MS in Information Science and Technology and although information security courses are offered, there is no concentration. The certificate provides this. Since all of the courses are already being offered, no additional resources are needed.

Zack Durlam moved to approve the new certificate. Jay Kapellusch seconded, and the motion carried.
C. Occupational Science and Technology, BS: Human Factors, Injury, and Performance

This is a program change creating a new track (aka sub-major), which addresses an emerging need in the industry. The program consists primarily of existing courses but includes two new courses - one intro and one capstone.

Sara Jozwik moved to approve the track and Aki Roberts seconded the motion. Jay Kapellusch abstained, and the motion passed.
D. Racial and Social Justice in Education, Graduate Certificate

The certificate addresses the critical need to overcome racial and social oppression in our society.
Shevaun Watson moved to approve the certificate. Murad Taani seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
